

Week 1

Books of the Old Testament (ALL)

(4-8) John 17:3 - "And this is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent."

(4-8) 2 Peter 1:21 - For prophecy never came by the will of man, but holy men of God spoke as they were moved by the Holy Spirit.

(4-8) 2 Timothy 3:15 - and that from childhood you have known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus.

(5-8) 2 Timothy 3:16 - All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness.

(6-8) Romans 12:1 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service.

(7-8) James 4:7 Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you.

(8) John 14:21 He who has My commandments and keeps them, it is he who loves Me. And he who loves Me will be loved by My Father, and I will love him and manifest Myself to him."

Week 2

Books of the New Testament (ALL)

(4-8) John 17:17 - "Sanctify them by Your truth. Your word is truth."

(4-8) Psalm 119:105 - Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.

(4-8) Romans 1:16 - For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek.

(5-8) 2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.

(6-8) Philippians 4:7 - And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

(7-8) Galatians 2:20 I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.

(8) Hebrews 12:6 For whom the Lord loves He chastens, And scourges every son whom He receives."

Week 3

First Commandment & Second Commandment

(4-8) Luke 11:28 - But He said, "More than that, blessed are those who hear the word of God and keep it!"

(4-8) Romans 6:23 - For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

(4-8) John 15:5 - "I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing."

(5-8) Ephesians 4:24 and that you put on the new man which was created according to God, in true righteousness and holiness.

(6-8) John 20:22–23 And when He had said this, He breathed on them, and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven them; if you retain the sins of any, they are retained."

(7-8) Psalm 1:1–3 Blessed is the man Who walks not in the counsel of the ungodly, Nor stands in the path of sinners, Nor sits in the seat of the scornful; But his delight is in the law of the Lord, And in His law he meditates day and night. He shall be like a tree Planted by the rivers of water, That brings forth its fruit in its season, Whose leaf also shall not wither; And whatever he does shall prosper.

(8) John 15:7 If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you.

Week 4

Third Commandment & Fourth Commandment

(4-8) John 3:16 - For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

(4-8) Luke 2:10,11 - Then the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid, for behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy which will be to all people. For there is born to you this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord."

(4-8) Galatians 4:4,5 - But when the fulness of the time had come, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the law, to redeem those who were under the law, that we might receive the adoption as sons.

(5-8) Isaiah 42:8 - "I am the LORD, that is My name; and My glory I will not give to another, nor My praise to carved images."

(6-8) Philippians 4:6–7 Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

(6-8) 1 Peter 5:6 Therefore humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you in due time.

(7-8) Micah 6:8 He has shown you, O man, what is good; And what does the Lord require of you But to do justly, To love mercy, And to walk humbly with your God?

(8) Galatians 5:17 For the flesh lusts against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; and these are contrary to one another, so that you do not do the things that you wish.

Week 5

Fifth Commandment

Sixth Commandment

(4-8) 1 John 4:19 - We love Him because He first loved us.

(4-8) Ephesians 4:32 And be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God in Christ forgave you.

(4-8) Romans 3:28 - Therefore we conclude that a man is justified by faith apart from the deeds of the law.

(5-8) Isaiah 41:10 Fear not, for I am with you; Be not dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you, Yes, I will help you, I will uphold you with My righteous right hand.'

(6-8) Titus 2:14 - [Jesus] gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from every lawless deed and purify for Himself His own special people, zealous for good works.

(7-8) John 1:12-13 But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name: who were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.

(8) John 5:24 "Most assuredly, I say to you, he who hears My word and believes in Him who sent Me has everlasting life, and shall not come into judgment, but has passed from death into life.

Week 6

Seventh Commandment

Eighth Commandment

(4-8) Proverbs 3:5 - Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and lean not on your own understanding.

(4-8) Matthew 18:20 - "For where two or three are gathered together in My name, I am there in the midst of them."

(4-8) Matthew 22:37-38 - Jesus said to him, "You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind. This is the first and great commandment."

(5-8) Matthew 22:39-40 - And the second is like it: "You shall love your neighbor as yourself." On these two commandments hang all the Law and the Prophets."

(6-8) Romans 16:17 - Now I urge you, brethren, note those who cause divisions and offenses, contrary to the doctrine which you learned, and avoid them.

(6-8) 1 Thessalonians 5:18 in everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.

(7-8) Revelation 3:20 Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and dine with him, and he with Me.

(8) Isaiah 55:10-11 "For as the rain comes down, and the snow from heaven, And do not return there, But water the earth, And make it bring forth and bud, That it may give seed to the sower And bread to the eater, So shall My word be that goes forth from My mouth; It shall not return to Me void, But it shall accomplish what I please, And it shall prosper in the thing for which I sent it.

Week 7

First Article of the Apostles Creed

(4-8) Psalm 37:5 - Commit your way to the LORD, trust also in Him, and He shall bring it to pass.

(4-8) 1 Peter 2:9 - But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light.

(4-8) John 10:27,28 - "My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me. And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand."

(5-8) Galatians 3:26,27 - For you are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus. For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ.

(6-8) Luke 9:23 Then He said to them all, "If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow Me.

(6-8) Ephesians 6:11 Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.

(7-8) Lamentations 3:22–23 Through the Lord's mercies we are not consumed, Because His compassions fail not. They are new every morning; Great is Your faithfulness.

(8) 2 Timothy 2:19 Nevertheless the solid foundation of God stands, having this seal: "The Lord knows those who are His," and, "Let everyone who names the name of Christ depart from iniquity."

Week 8

First Article of the Apostles Creed

(4-8) Psalm 124:8 - Our help is in the name of the LORD, Who made heaven and earth.

(4-8) Matthew 4:10 - "You shall worship the LORD your God, and Him only you shall serve."

(4-8) Romans 8:32 He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things?

(5-8) 1 Corinthians 3:16 Do you not know that you are the temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you?

(6-8) Matthew 28:18-20 - "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age."

(7-8) 2 Timothy 2:22 Flee also youthful lusts; but pursue righteousness, faith, love, peace with those who call on the Lord out of a pure heart.

(8) Acts 4:20 For we cannot but speak the things which we have seen and heard."

Week 9

Second Article of the Apostles Creed

(4-8) Matthew 1:21 - "And she will bring forth a Son, and you shall call His name JESUS, for He will save His people from their sins."

(4-8) Matthew 7:7 - "Ask, and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you."

(4-8) Romans 12:2 And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

(5-8) Isaiah 40:28 Have you not known? Have you not heard? The everlasting God, the Lord, The Creator of the ends of the earth, Neither faints nor is weary. His understanding is unsearchable.

(6-8) Matthew 15:19 - For out of the heart proceed evil thoughts, murders, adulteries, fornications, thefts, false witnesses, blasphemies.

(7-8) Matthew 7:15 - "Beware of false prophets, who come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravenous wolves."

(8) Psalm 119:9-11 How can a young man cleanse his way? By taking heed according to Your word. With my whole heart I have sought You; Oh, let me not wander from Your commandments! Your word I have hidden in my heart, That I might not sin against You.

Week 10

Second Article of the Apostles Creed

(4-8) John 15:13 - Greater love has no one than this, than to lay down one's life for his friends.

(4-8) Genesis 2:24 - Therefore a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and they shall become one flesh.

(4-8) John 11:25,26 - Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall live. And whoever lives and believes in Me shall never die. Do you believe this?"

(5-8) Hebrews 12:2 looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.

(6-8) John 16:23 - "Most assuredly, I say to you, whatever you ask the Father in My name He will give you."

(6-8) Luke 12:15 - Take heed and beware of covetousness, for one's life does not consist in the abundance of the things he possesses.

(7-8) Romans 8:38-39 For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

(8) 1 Corinthians 15:58 Therefore, my beloved brethren, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that your labor is not in vain in the Lord.

Week 11

Third Article of the Apostles Creed

(4-8) 1 John 3:15 - Whoever hates his brother is a murderer, and you know that no murderer has eternal life abiding in him.

(4-8) 1 John 1:7 - The blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin.

(4-8) Psalm 51:10 - Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me.

(5-8) Matthew 11:28–30 Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For My yoke is easy and My burden is light.”

(6-8) 2 Corinthians 5:19 - God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not imputing their trespasses to them, and has committed to us the word of reconciliation.

(7-8) 2 Corinthians 9:7 So let each one give as he purposes in his heart, not grudgingly or of necessity; for God loves a cheerful giver.

(8) Deuteronomy 31:8 And the Lord, He is the One who goes before you. He will be with you, He will not leave you nor forsake you; do not fear nor be dismayed.”

Week 12

Third Article of the Apostles Creed

(4-8) Psalm 24:1 - The earth is the Lord's and all its fullness, the world and those who dwell therein.

(4-8) Romans 8:28 - And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose.

(4-8) 2 Corinthians 8:9 - For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though He was rich, yet for your sakes He became poor, that you through His poverty might become rich.

(5-8) 2 Corinthians 8:15 As it is written, “He who gathered much had nothing left over, and he who gathered little had no lack.”

(5-8) Acts 16:30,31 - “Sirs, what must I do to be saved?” So they said, “Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and you will be saved, you and your household.”

(6-8) Ephesians 4:25 - Therefore, putting away lying, let each one of you speak truth with his neighbor, for we are members of one another.

(7-8) John 13:34–35 A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another. By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another.”

(8) John 6:37 All that the Father gives Me will come to Me, and the one who comes to Me I will by no means cast out.

Week 13

Baptism I - What is Baptism?

(4-8) Psalm 51:5 - Behold, I was brought forth in iniquity, and in sin my mother conceived me.

(4-8) Galatians 3:13 - Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree")

(4-8) Proverbs 1:10 - My son, if sinners entice you, do not consent.

(5-8) Philippians 2:3-4 Let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind let each esteem others better than himself. Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others.

(6-8) 1 Corinthians 11:28 - But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of that bread and drink of that cup.

(7-8) 1 John 3:18 My little children, let us not love in word or in tongue, but in deed and in truth.

(8) Philippians 4:11-13 Not that I speak in regard to need, for I have learned in whatever state I am, to be content: I know how to be abased, and I know how to abound. Everywhere and in all things I have learned both to be full and to be hungry, both to abound and to suffer need. I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me.

Week 14

Baptism II - What are the benefits of Baptism?

(4-8) Romans 10:17 - So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

(4-8) Genesis 1:1 - In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.

(4-8) Psalm 139:14 - I will praise You, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made; marvelous are Your works, and that my soul knows very well.

(5-8) Acts 4:12 - Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved.

(6-8) Luke 9:23 Then He said to them all, "If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow Me.

(6-8) Romans 14:17 for the kingdom of God is not eating and drinking, but righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit.

(7-8) Ephesians 5:3 But fornication and all uncleanness or covetousness, let it not even be named among you, as is fitting for saints;

(8) Joshua 24:15 And if it seems evil to you to serve the Lord, choose for yourselves this day whom you will serve, whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the River, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land you dwell. But as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord."

Week 15

Baptism III - How can water do such great things?

(4-8) Psalm 145:15,16 - The eyes of all look expectantly to You, and You give them their food in due season. You open Your hand and satisfy the desire of every living thing.

(4-8) 1 Peter 5:7- Casting all your care upon Him, for He cares for you.

(4-8) Ephesians 2:8–9 For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, not of works, lest anyone should boast.

(5-8) John 3:3 - Jesus answered, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God."

(6-8) Ephesians 2:10 For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.

(6-8) Matthew 6:33 - "But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you."

(7-8) Hebrews 11:3 - By faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that the things which are seen were not made of things which are visible.

(8) Galatians 6:9–10 And let us not grow weary while doing good, for in due season we shall reap if we do not lose heart. Therefore, as we have opportunity, let us do good to all, especially to those who are of the household of faith.

Week 16

Baptism IV - What is the meaning of this Baptism with water?

(4-8) John 1:29 - The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, "Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!"

(4-8) Genesis 3:15 - "And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed and her Seed; He shall bruise your head, and you shall bruise His heel."

(4-8) Matthew 5:16 Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.

(5-8) 1 Timothy 2:5 - For there is one God and one Mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus.

(6-8) Matthew 16:24 - Then Jesus said to His disciples "If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow Me."

(7-8) Deuteronomy 6:4–5 "Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one! You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength.

(8) Jeremiah 23:28 "The prophet who has a dream, let him tell a dream; And he who has My word, let him speak My word faithfully. What is the chaff to the wheat?" says the Lord.

Week 17

Sacr Altar I - What is the Sacrament of the Altar?

(4-8) Psalm 50:15 - "Call upon Me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you, and you shall glorify Me."

(4-8) John 8:31 - Then Jesus said to those Jews who believed him, "If you abide in My word, you are My disciples indeed."

(4-8) Galatians 5:22-23 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law.

(5-8) Psalm 19:1 The heavens declare the glory of God; And the firmament shows His handiwork.

(6-8) Proverbs 30:5 Every word of God is pure; He is a shield to those who put their trust in Him.

(6-8) 1 Corinthians 12:3 Therefore I make known to you that no one speaking by the Spirit of God calls Jesus accursed, and no one can say that Jesus is Lord except by the Holy Spirit.

(7-8) John 14:27 Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.

(8) Luke 10:16 - "He who hears you hears Me, he who rejects you rejects Me, and he who rejects Me rejects Him who sent Me."

Week 18

Sacr Altar II - What is the benefit of this eating and drinking?

(4-8) Mark 10:45 - "For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many."

(4-8) John 14:19 - "Because I live, you will live also."

Ephesians 4:24 - And that you put on the new man which was created according to God, in righteousness and true holiness.

(4-8) 1 Timothy 2:4 - God our Savior desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.

(5-8) Isaiah 43:1 But now, thus says the Lord, who created you, O Jacob, And He who formed you, O Israel: "Fear not, for I have redeemed you; I have called you by your name; You are Mine.

(6-8) 1 Peter 5:8 - Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour.

(7-8) 1 Peter 1:18,19 - Knowing that you were not redeemed with corruptible things, like silver and gold, from your aimless conduct received by tradition from your fathers, but with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot.

(8) Colossians 3:16 Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.

Week 19

Sacr Altar III - How can simple eating and drinking do such wonderful things?

(4-8) Psalm 27:1 The Lord is my light and my salvation; Whom shall I fear? The Lord is the strength of my life; Of whom shall I be afraid?

(4-8) Matthew 26:41 Watch and pray, lest you enter into temptation. The spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak."

(4-8) Romans 3:23–24 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus,

(5-8) Isaiah 40:31 But those who wait on the Lord Shall renew their strength; They shall mount up with wings like eagles, They shall run and not be weary, They shall walk and not faint.

(6-8) Isaiah 53:5,6 - But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; the chastisement for our peace was upon Him, and by His stripes we are healed. All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned everyone to his own way; and the LORD has laid on Him the iniquity of us all.

(7-8) 2 Corinthians 13:14 - The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with you.

(8) Hebrews 11:6 But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.

Week 20

Sacr Altar IV - When is an individual properly prepared to receive this Sacrament?

(4-8) 2 Peter 3:9 - The Lord is not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance.

(4-8) Psalm 46:1 God is our refuge and strength, A very present help in trouble.

(4-8) Psalm 46:10 Be still, and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth!

(5-8) 1 Corinthians 10:31 - Therefore, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God.

(6-8) Philippians 2:5-7 - Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus, who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men.

(7-8) Philippians 2:8 And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross.

(8) Philippians 2:9-11 - Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
