Genesis 2 is retelling the event of creation by zooming in and focusing on humans who are going to inhabit this world, fill it, and rule over it. Genesis 1 is big picture, cosmic. Genesis 2 is focused smaller: garden, home, family, responsibility, life with God.

Opening Thoughts: What do you think about God's statement: "It is not good that man should be alone..." Why? How does loneliness affect someone? How does God's design for family also impact our society as a whole? What does the word "family" relate to how we think about "church"?
